


Accessing First Class From Home – Mac OS X: Accessing First Class From The Internet:

To access first class from home, first open up your Internet browser (Firefox / Safari / Opera etc.) and input the following address:

<http://fc.swbgs.com>


You will have the option to download the First Class client or use the web-login. Note that the web-login can be accessed from any computer, but will have limited features.

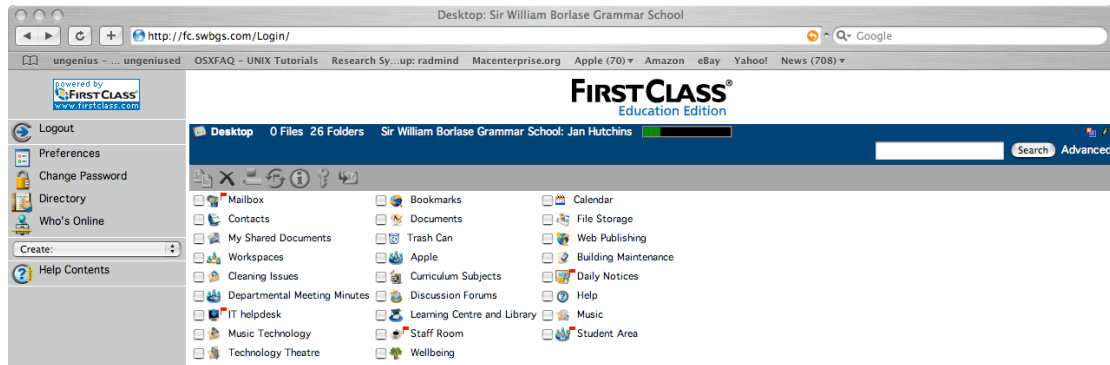
To log in to the web-based version of First Class, click the **login icon**.


**Enter your user ID and password in the appropriate fields and click 'login'.



You will be presented with the webpage below; you will have to choose which version of First Class Client to install. E.g.: If you are using Mac OS X as your operating system at home, then you would select the **Mac version. The download is a Universal Binary (UB) and will work on both Power PC (PPC) and the newer Intel chipsets. Click on the **version link that you require**. There are versions for Mac OS 9 / OS X, Windows and Linux.**



When the Login screen appears, simply enter your user ID and password and click Login.

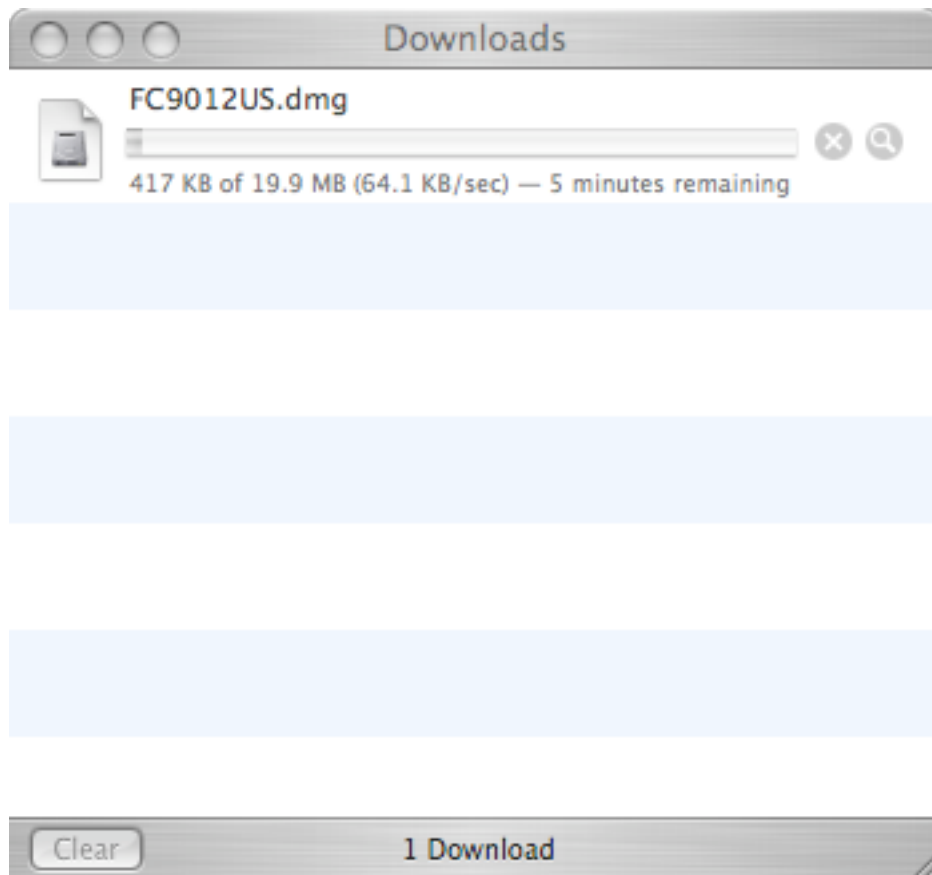

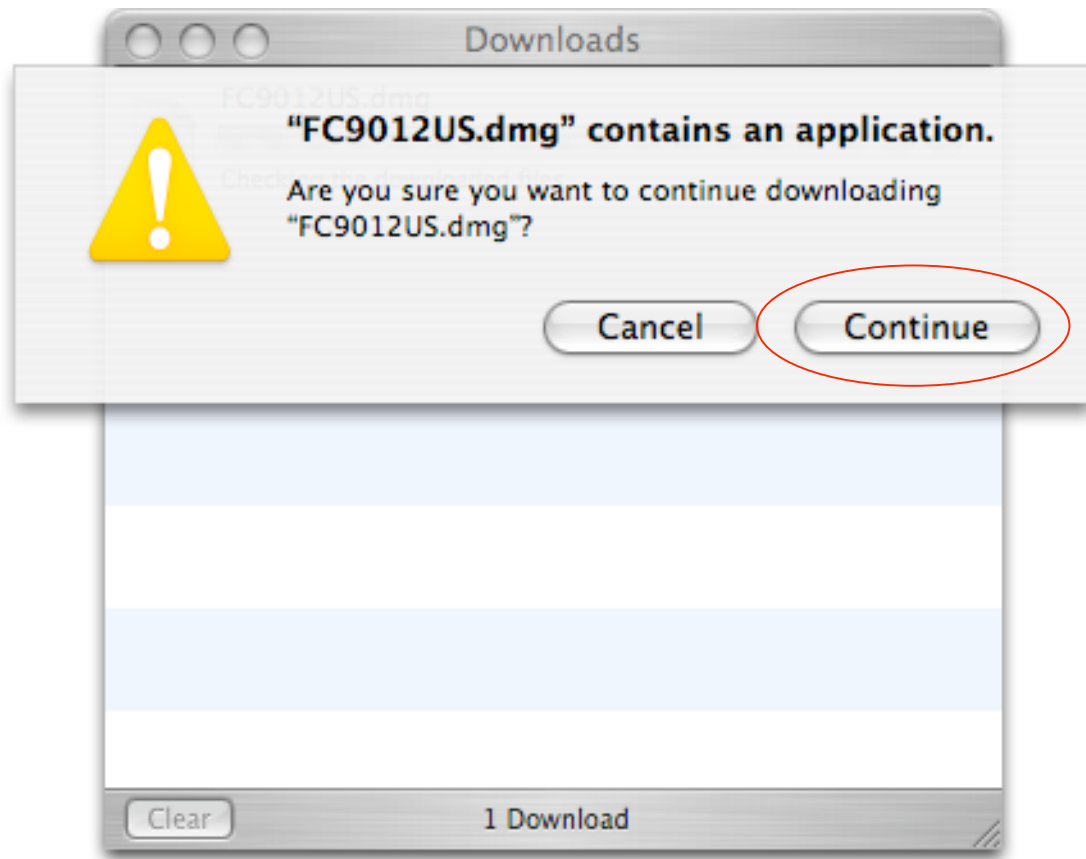

After clicking on the link, (depending on your browser) you will be presented with a download screen or dialogue. In this instance, using the built-in OS X Internet browser 'Safari', you will be presented with the following window; which will start your download automatically.



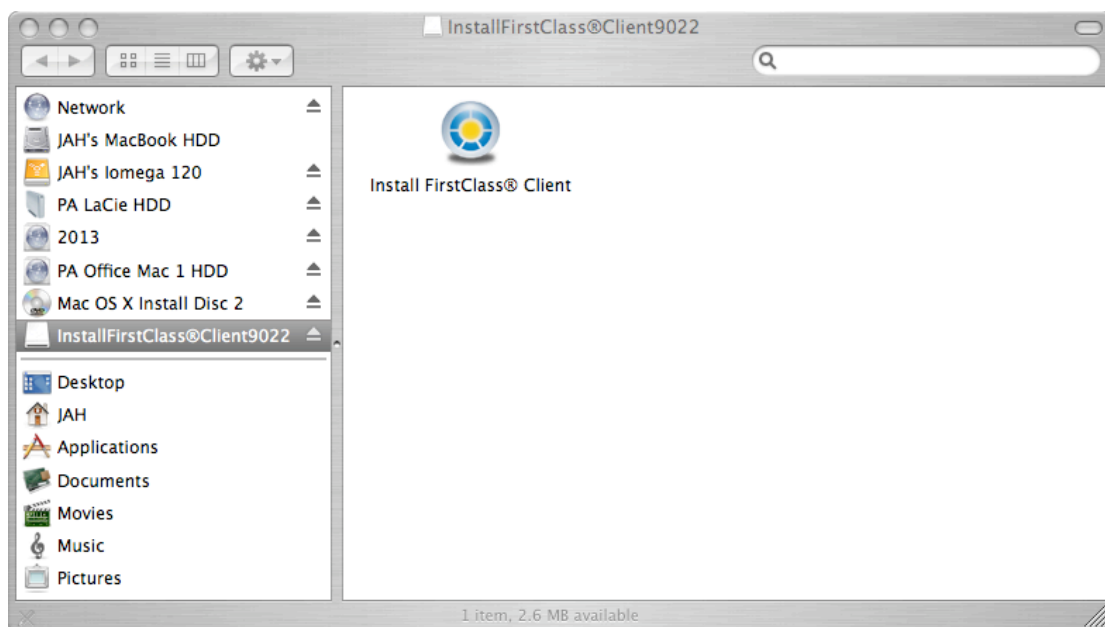
Note that on other browsers you may be asked to confirm the download and its intended location before continuing – the default finished download location is on your desktop.

After the download has finished, you will be presented with the following dialogue:



Click 'continue'.

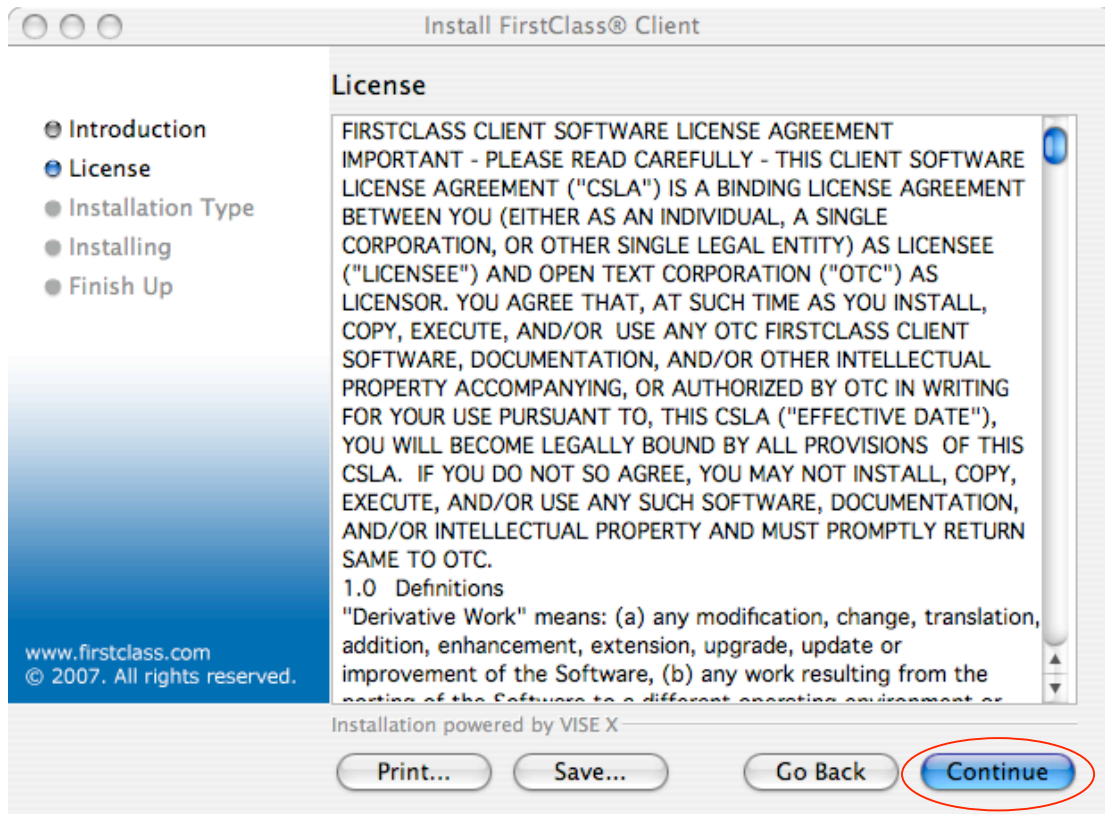
The downloaded disk image file (.dmg) will mount on your desktop automatically, and a window displaying its contents will pop up:



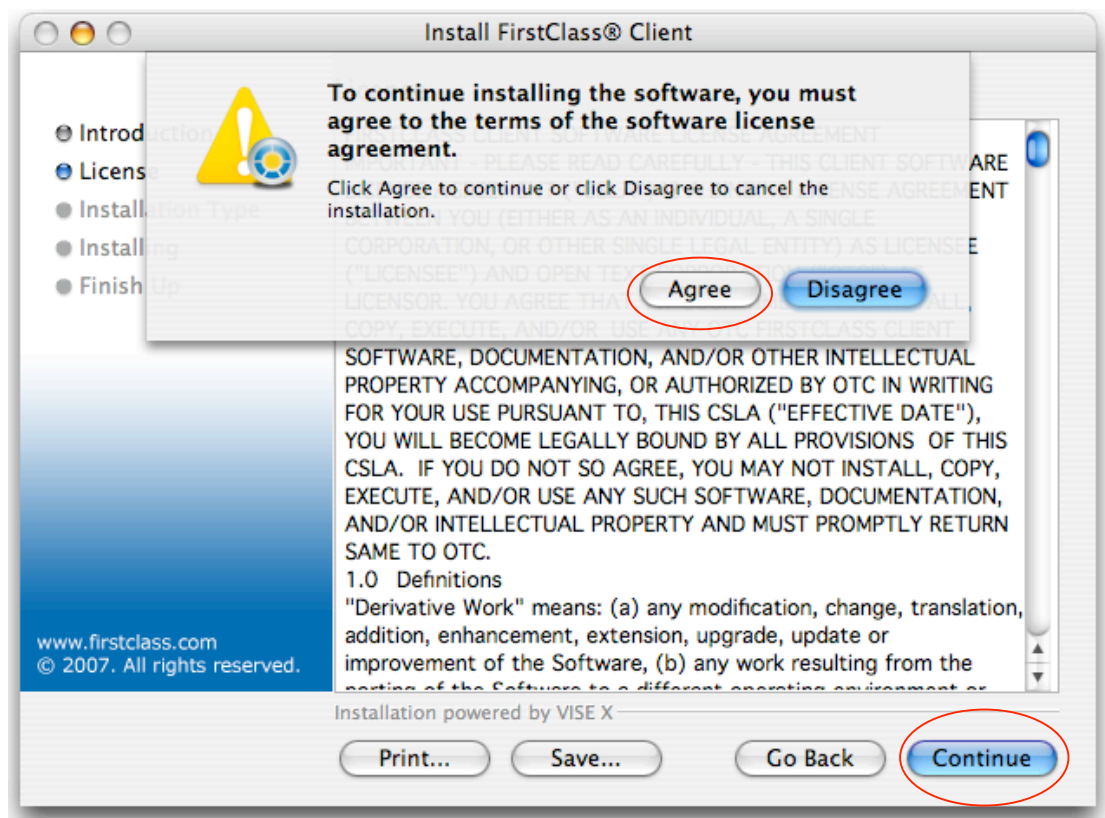
Double-click the 'Install FirstClass Client' icon to launch setup – in the following window, click 'continue':



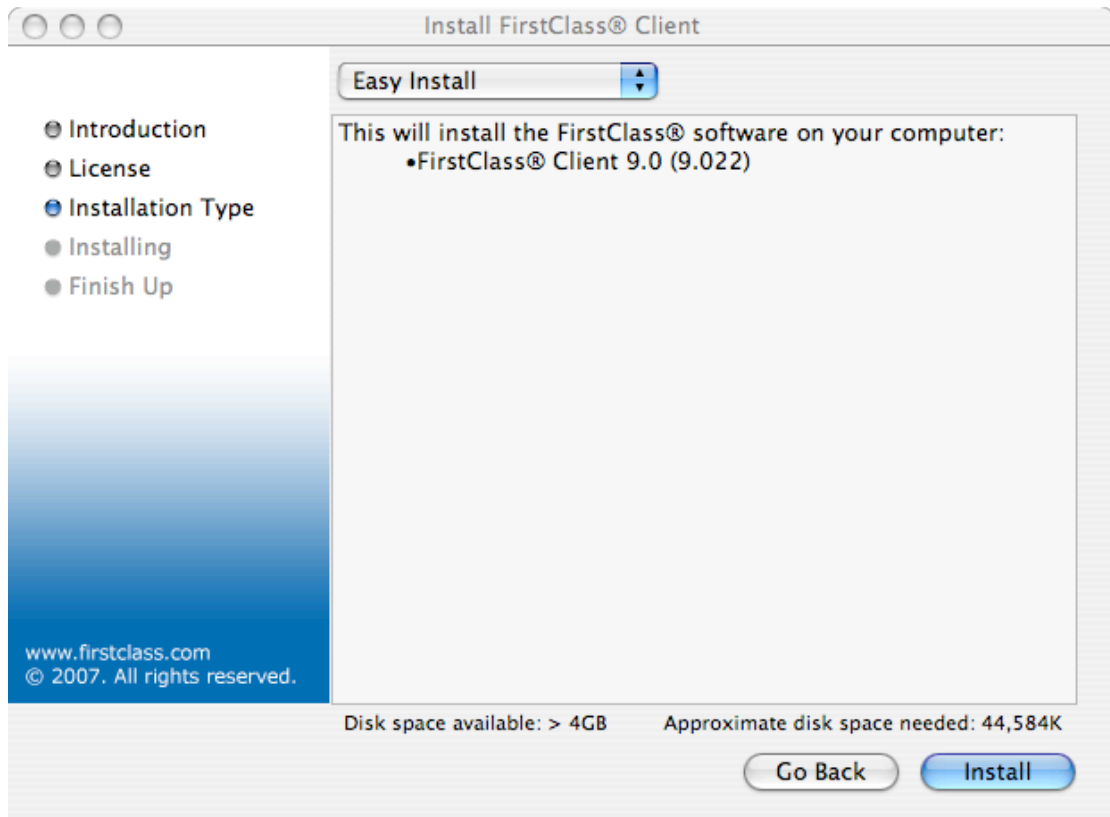
After reading the 'License Agreement' the you are presented with, click 'continue' again:



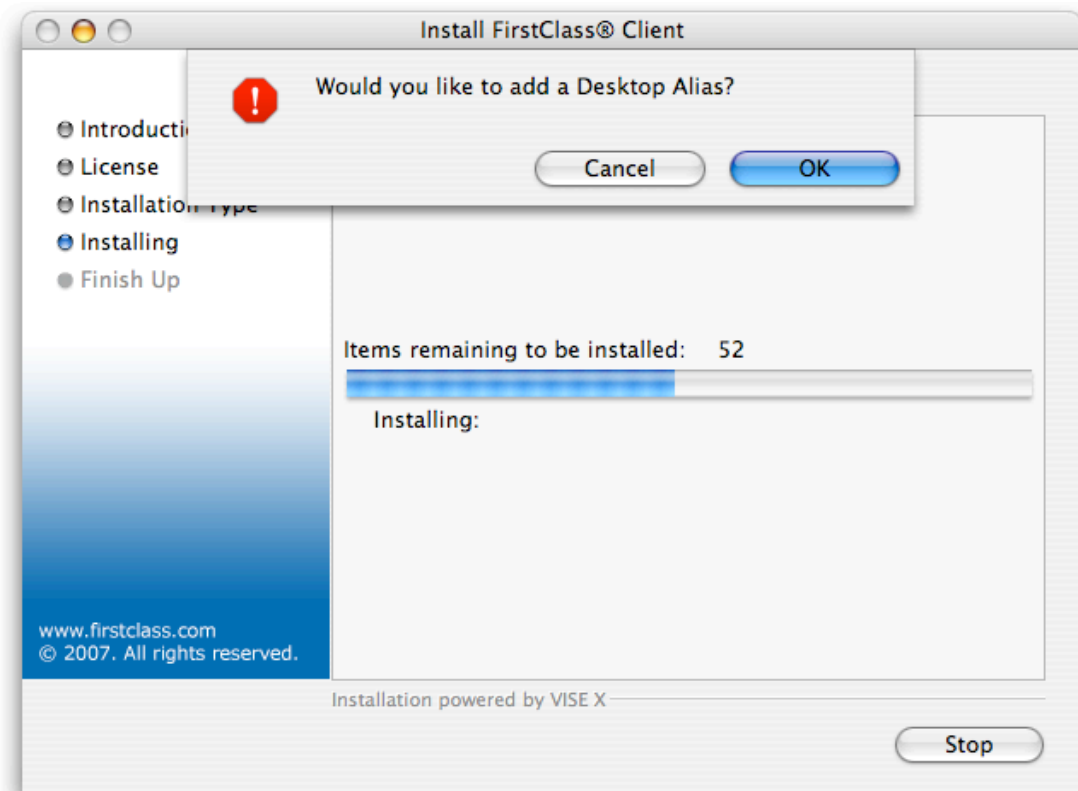
Once again you will be presented with a confirmation dialogue, click 'agree' and then 'continue':



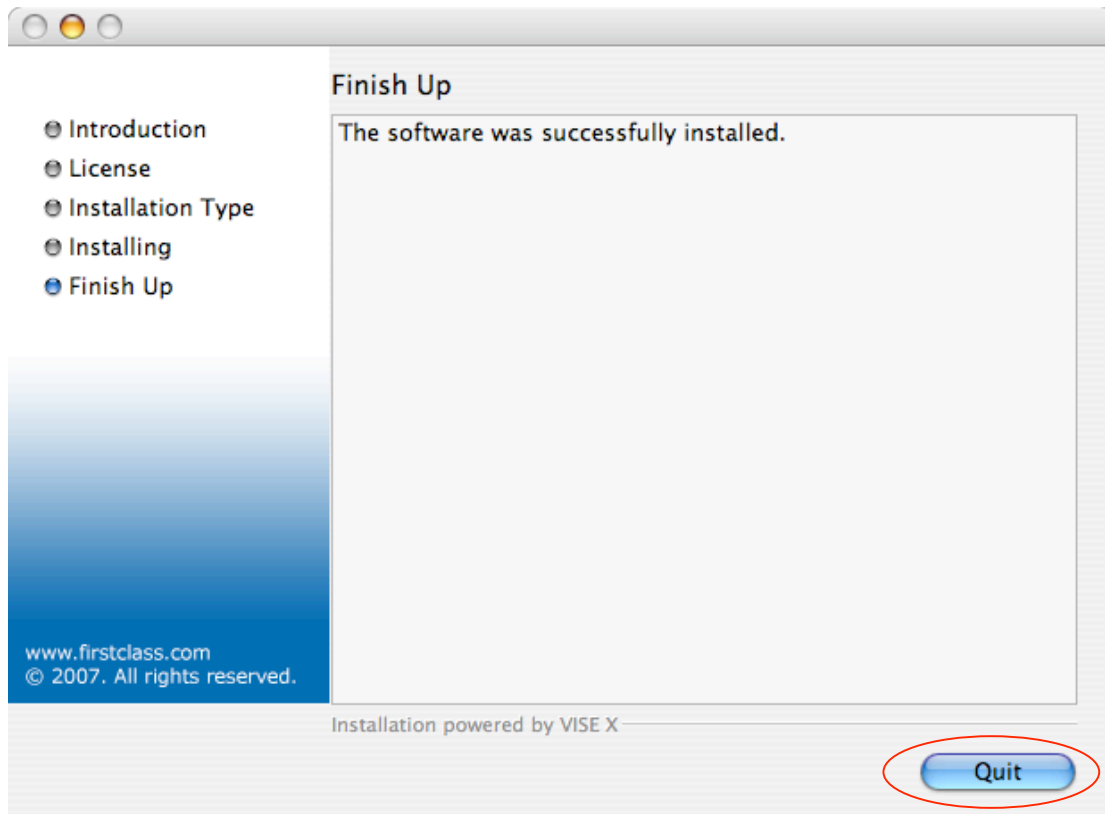
At the next screen, just click 'install'. This will, by default, install the application in the 'Applications' folder on your hard-drive.



The next screen will ask you if you wish to add a 'desktop alias' or shortcut. Choose your desired option.



The next screen will inform you that the install process has finished. Click 'quit'.



You must now launch the application 'FirstClass' from your applications directory. The program will now launch and present you with a log-on screen. Make sure that next to the 'server' field 'fc.swbgs.com' is shown. If this is not the case, continue using the next steps: Click the 'setup' button.
