The Head of PE and Sport will lead a highly successful department with a proven record of academic and sporting success. They will work in close liaison with staff to ensure effective curricular and extra-curricular provision of PE and sport.

The school is about to embark on a £3 million building project that will include enhanced sporting facilities. We also have close partnerships with several local sports clubs and all local primary schools, as well as the wider community.

Roles and responsibilities for Head of PE and Sport

- Performance management of a team of PE and sports specialists.
- Ensuring all appropriate department health and safety procedures are in place.
- Managing and having oversight of a full extra-curricular programme. This will include an overview of major sports and the management of relevant teachers in charge of all major sports including the two specialist Directors of Hockey and Rowing and their respective programmes.
- Having an overview on additional internal and external coaches within various sports offered.
- Take a lead role in at least one major sport per term together with other teachers in charge of sports.
- Organising the annual Senior Sports Dinner.
- Coordinating the Inter House sports programme.
- Overseeing sports communications including, sports calendars, newsletters and the school website.
- Ensuring a highly valued and consistent sports Colours system.
- Curriculum planning that will meet the needs of the National Curriculum.
- Planning and overseeing the staffing arrangements for all curriculum matters within PE including GCSE and A Level.
- Managing budgets for PE and Sport across the academic year.
- Overseeing the Wednesday afternoon Sixth Form sports programme in terms of staffing senior teams and additional activities that could be offered as recreational activities for non 1st team players.
- Attending Heads of Department meetings.

- Ensuring an accurate, consistent and robust system of assessment and target setting within the PE department that meets the needs of pupils at SWBGs.
- Regular department lesson observations, drop ins and learning walks.
- Utilising ICT opportunities to enhance learning opportunities, communication and other relevant areas within the school and PE department.
- To align PE developments with those of the whole school including Google drive and Realsmart developments.
- Ensuring high-quality CPD within the department.
- Attending termly Wycombe district department meetings.
- Setting agendas and ensuring minutes of regular PE departmental meetings.
- Line manage and support School Games Organiser.
- Coordinating and embedding a School Sports Committee (pupil voice) and using senior Sports Prefects in weekly and annual events
- Being section member representative of SWBGS at Marlow Sports Club.
- Working with site team to coordinate line markings and facility preparation throughout the year.
- Working with appropriate school systems to ensure the upkeep and development of PE buildings and facilities.
- Coordinating and delivering for year 6 Open evening, and A Level PE open evening.
