SIR WILLIAM BORLASE'S GRAMMAR SCHOOL

Sir William Borlase's Grammar School is a selective entry, co-educational grammar school located in the centre of the attractive Thames-side town of Marlow, Buckinghamshire. The school has an excellent academic record, placing well on a variety of national league tables, and is very heavily over-subscribed. Standards of attainment are well above the national average, and above those achieved by comparable selective schools at all age levels. The school also has a justifiably high reputation for the performance of its various school sports teams and for its many other extra-curricular activities.

The most recent OFSTED report (July 2012) described the school as good with outstanding in all areas.

In recent years the school has successfully completed a programme of major improvements to facilities in all areas, including new staff accommodation, sixth form facilities, a new learning centre, new catering and a new purpose built theatre and Design and Technology Centre. All classrooms have full network access, with interactive whiteboards and some access to a bank of dedicated laptops for data logging and other class work. Further improvements to ICT provision are currently being planned.

Mathematics Department

The Mathematics Department at Borlase's is a large and successful Department, with an excellent record at GCSE, A Level and university entrance. Currently, it comprises eight full-time and part-time teachers and is housed in a suite of specialist rooms all equipped with interactive whiteboards.

Pupils are taught in their form groupings in Year 7, after which they move into a flexible setting system. All pupils have up-to-date textbooks, which may be used both at home and at school.

At GCSE, pupils follow the linear syllabus set by the Edexcel Board. All five sets follow the Higher Level Course, with the top set currently sitting the examination in Year 10. They then study AS Mathematics in Year 11, while set 2 study Additional Mathematics FSMQ alongside the GCSE. In 2013, over 55% of our pupils attained A* grade, increasing to 86% A*/A and 99% for A* to B.

KS5 mathematics is an extremely popular option choice. Currently in Year 12 over 50 students are studying Further Mathematics, and a further 70 are studying Single Mathematics. Over three-quarters continue their study in year 13 and many students opt to study mathematics-related subjects at University. In 2012, 2 pupils went on to read Mathematics at Oxford and Cambridge, with another 4 students going on to study Mathematics at Warwick, Imperial and Exeter. Pupils follow the EDEXCEL syllabuses at Mathematics and Further Mathematics. In 2013, 76% of our A Level students gained an A*/A/B grade.
